



Small wonder

Squeezed, *moi?* Measuring just 6 metres by 6 metres, the Hanse-Colani-Rotorhaus aims to be the ultimate compact home. The futuristic, cedar-covered property centres on a drum with a diameter of 3.7 metres. The motorised cylinder, which contains the kitchen, bathroom and sleeping room, rotates to reveal the three "pods", allowing the space to be configured in three different ways. The brainchild of Professor Luigi Colani, who describes himself as "an unabashed *agent provocateur* of the design world", it is designed to "provide a house with the minimum interior measurements, but the maximum space to live in". Prototypes are being built at the company's factory in Bavaria, but orders — and building regs approval — have yet to come flooding in.
